Yeongin Kim joined University of Cincinnati as an Assistant Professor in 2022. Before that, he had worked as a postdoctoral researcher at Massachusetts Institute of Technology from 2018 to 2021. He received a PhD degree in Electrical Engineering from Stanford University in 2018. Prof. Kim has focused on innovation in organic/inorganic material growth/synthesis for electronic/optical/chemical/energy devices for the last 10 year, which resulted in 29 academic papers in high-impact journals, such as Science and Nature, and 4 pending/granted US patents. His research was highlighted as “Top 5 Breakthrough Innovations of 2022” by Lab Worldwide and “2018 South Korea TOP 5 Biological Research Achievement, Category: Biology and Convergence” by Biological Research Information Center.
